Dear Elementary & Middle Level Principals,

The **Wyoming Association of Elementary and Middle School Principals**, is pleased to announce the **SUMMER READING PROGRAM** for the summer of 2018. This program is designed to promote individual reading efforts by students and to involve the association in a service to the students of Wyoming. This is an excellent opportunity to add to your public relations efforts for your school and your professional association and it will also help to fight the “summer regression” in reading skills that many of our students experience.

We have made every effort to keep this program simple and easily manageable for all concerned. You may include any level of students in this program. Students who are unable to read may count the time they are read to by others. You are encouraged to even get your new incoming kindergarten students participating in this program.

Schools and students who participate in the SUMMER READING PROGRAM will receive an attractive certificate of participation (provided by WAEMSP). Principals are also encouraged to recognize each participant by providing them with a book of their choice, which can be ordered inexpensively from any of the traditional book clubs. You may think of other creative incentives that you would want to offer for reaching specific school goals. Schools and principals that have the highest per capita reading time for the months of June, July, and August, will receive an attractive recognition plaque and also be recognized during the WAEMSP Conference in January. Awards will be presented in five (5) categories, based on school enrollment.

Please remember that this is for fun and enjoyment more than competition. You will find attached the following materials that you will need to join other elementary schools in the state in the SUMMER READING PROGRAM:

- a letter to students and their parents explaining the program (reproducible on your letterhead)
- a record sheet for each student to record reading time (reproducible)
- a report form to be completed by the principal and submitted by September 28th

Upon receipt of the report, your school will be sent an electronic award certificate which you may print to present to your participating students. An announcement of the top schools in each category along with their recognition plaques will be mailed in October.
